With the holidays just around the corner, El Hogar del Niño is calling on the community to help spread some joy to more than 300 children through their annual Toy Drive. "It feels very rewarding to know that we are able to help families during this time who may not be able to provide a toy to their children this year," said Viviana Vergara, home base supervisor for El Hogar del Niño.

Since 1972, El Hogar del Niño has been serving Chicago's predominately Latino neighborhoods of Pilsen and Little Village. The organization provides

high-quality childcare services. preschool services, and provides home visit services to pregnant women, infants, and toddlers to promote the school readiness of young children from low-income families. "We try our best to meet the families where they are at; we try to understand that not only are times changing, but also understanding that development and education is changing, and we want to be the people that are there to support them along the way. For us, its collaboration, and that feeling of we are just another person in your village to help take care of your child," said Vergara. As many years

before, El Hogar del Niño is counting on compassionate individuals to help make the holidays even more special by checking out the organization's Amazon wish list and donating. A lot of care goes into crafting the list, added Vergara. "We really become in tuned with our family and children's needs. There is strong communication between our home specialists and families, our teachers and children. We have children that are special needs or have language delays, so we take all that into consideration. So, parents' feedback, feedback from our teacher and education coordinators, and feedback from support specialists and we make those decisions

based on what we think our kids might like and what they might need. So, toys can be so much fun, but we try to ensure that the toys are also developmentally appropriate. We want to make sure that there are things they are having fun with but also going to be learning with."

For those unable to give a monetary donation, there is a plethora of other ways to help. "A lot of things we can try to provide, too, is staff volunteering aspect. So maybe if you can't provide joy from purchasing a toy, there's an opportunity to volunteer, or to spread the word. It's the idea of fulfilling that purpose of giving. It's not just about the money, it's also about helping, it's about being the voice, being the people to push out what we are trying to do. If you donate that would be amazing, but there are other ways people can help." Holiday Cheers, not Tears: 'Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over,' 'Drive High, Get a DUI'



With the holiday season just around the corner, the Berwyn Police Department has joined forces with the Illinois Department of Transportation for the "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" and "Drive High, Get a DUI" enforcement campaign to ensure that festive gatherings do not end in tragedy. From Dec. 13 through Jan. 2, law enforcement agencies across Illinois will adopt a zero-tolerance policy for impaired driving to keep our roads safe. "This season, let's make safety our shared priority," said Chief Michael D. Cimaglia, "If you plan to drink or use impairing substances, plan ahead for a sober ride home. Driving impaired isn't just dangerous - it's unacceptable. We'll be out in full force, and no excuses will be accepted." The Berwyn Police Department urges everyone to take the following simple steps to prevent impaired driving: •Plan ahead: Designate a sober driver, use public transportation or arrange for a ride-sharing service. •Report dangers: If you spot an impaired driver, pull over safely and contact local police. •Be a hero: Stop a friend from driving impaired by taking their keys and helping them get home safely. •Buckle up: It's your best defense against impaired drivers. Make this holiday season memorable for

all the right reasons. Celebrate responsibly and help ensure everyone gets home safely. This campaign is made possible through federal highway safety funds from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration administered by IDOT.

Illinois Minimum Wage Increasing on January 1 Most hourly workers will see an increase of \$1 an hour on their paystubs

Workers will see an increase of \$1 per hour from \$14 to \$15. The minimum wage for tipped workers will rise to \$9 per hour and youth workers (under 18) working fewer than 650 hours per calendar year will see their hourly wage increase to \$13 per hour. This is the seventh and final increase in the state's minimum wage that was included in legislation signed by Governor Pritzker in 2019, establishing a schedule of increases resulting in a \$15 per hour minimum wage in 2025. Minimum wage workers are encouraged to review their paystubs in the new year to ensure they are being paid correctly. Workers in the City of Chicago are required to be paid at a higher rate, depending on the size of



their employer. Employees can file a minimum wage complaint with IDOL or by



New Laws Take Effect in 2025

With the New Year quickly approaching, a number of new state laws will take effect. Nearly 300 laws will officially be on the books beginning Jan. 1 -from one that fights catalytic converter theft to another that makes it easier to cancel online subscriptions. In the New Year, victims of car theft won't be on the hook for towing and storage fees, families can expect lower out-of-pocket EpiPen costs and more. The Illinois Senate Democratic Caucus outlined the top 10 laws affecting Illinoisans in the upcoming year. These include: •HB 2443: Insurers must now cover medically prescribed hearing aids and services for individuals of all ages, ensuring access to essential care.

•**HB** 3639: Life-saving epinephrine injectors are now capped at \$60 per twin-pack, making allergy care more affordable.

•HB 4589: Recyclable metals dealers must track vehicle and part information for catalytic converters to prevent illegal sales. •HB 4911: Gym memberships can now be canceled online or via email if those options were used to join the contract. •HB 5561: Employees protected are from retaliation for exposing workplace practices they believe violate the law. •SB 2654: Vehicles that are stolen and later towed will not incur storage fees if recovered within seven days, and owners can retrieve essential items, like medical devices and textbooks.

•SB 2764: Businesses offering free trials longer than 15 days must email consumers three days before the cancellation deadline.

•SB 3201: Law enforcement will now be trained to better recognize and respond to individuals with autism. •SB 3471: Illinois drivers can now request free replacement plates if their license plates are stolen.

•SB 3479: Businesses offering veteran or military benefit services for a fee must disclose all terms upfront.

The City of Chicago Department of Family and Support Services (DFSS) invited Chicago leaders, youth-serving stakeholders and young people to the Harold Washington Library Center Winter Garden for the December My CHI. My Future. (MCMF) citywide partners meeting. This meeting provided an opportunity to hear from the MCMF Community Anchor Organizations about their efforts to stakeholder convene networks and develop community plans focused

on meeting the needs of youth in their communities. Organizations representing 15 regions across the city are presenting data identified through a community needs assessment and outline strategies to address opportunity gaps for young people. Mayor Johnson invested \$14.2 million across the MCMF initiative through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) as part of Mayor Johnson's Road to Recovery Plan. Since 2023, the Community Anchor Organizations program has

funded 15 delegate agencies to serve as Community Anchors, bringing together community stakeholders dedicated to youth development. The goal of the program is to create strategies that connect young people of all ages to engaging and meaningful out-of-school time programs in each of the 15 MCMF Community Strategy Regions. El espacio de la histórica Rotonda del Acuario Shedd regresa con una nueva exhibición, Wonder of Water (Maravilla Acuática), Wonder of Water presenta dos hábitats llenos de actividad: un ecosistema de agua dulce y otro de agua salada. Wonder of Water establece el tono para un viaje asombroso al mundo de los animales acuáticos, donde los visitantes pueden pararse en el corazón del acuario entre dos entornos claramente ricos, para sumergirse en la biodiversidad de la vida debajo de la superficie

del agua. Las dinámicas y diversas exhibiciones presentan corales vivos, plantas de agua fresca y una colorida variedad de peces, diseñados a cambiar contínuamente en un estado de crecimiento. El Sueldo Mínimo de Illinois Aumenta el 1º de Enero

La mayoría de trabajadores por hora verán un aumento de \$1 la hora en sus tabulaciones de pago

Los trabajadores verán un aumento de \$1 por hora, de \$14 a \$15. El salario mínimo para los trabajadores con propina aumentará a \$9 por hora y los trabajadores jóvenes (de menos de 18 años) que trabajan menos de 650 horas por año verán su salario por hora aumentar a \$13 por hora. Este es el séptimo y final aumento en el salario mínimo del estado que fue incluído en una legislación firmada por el Gobernador Pritzker en el 2019, estableciendo un programa de aumentos resultando en \$15 por hora como salario mínimo en el 2025. Se aconseja a los trabajadores de salario mínimo que revisen sus tabulaciones de cheques en el año nuevo para estar seguros de que se les paga correctamente. Se requiere que los trabajadores de la ciudad de Chicago deben recibir un salario más alto,

según el tamaño de su empleador. Los empleados pueden presentar una queja sobre el salario mínimo ante IDOL o llamando a la línea directa gratuita sobre salario mínimo: (800) 478-3998.
